Roles

A key part of our study process will be the creation of two Community Advisory Groups; one to represent Richland County and the other Lawrence County. The groups will:

- *Ensure that the opinions of the broader community are shared with the IDOT project team.*
- *Ensure that information developed by the project team is distributed throughout the community.*
- *Help ensure that the best possible design is identified.*



In carrying out these functions, the CAG will play an important role in defining the area's important features, identifying access preferences, and recognizing potential highway effects.

Responsibilities

Advisory Group members will be expected to carry out the following responsibilities:



- *Attend each CAG meeting and participate in Group discussion and activities.*
- *Participate openly and honestly, respecting the opinions of other Group members.*
- *Represent their organization, constituency, or broader community interests.*
