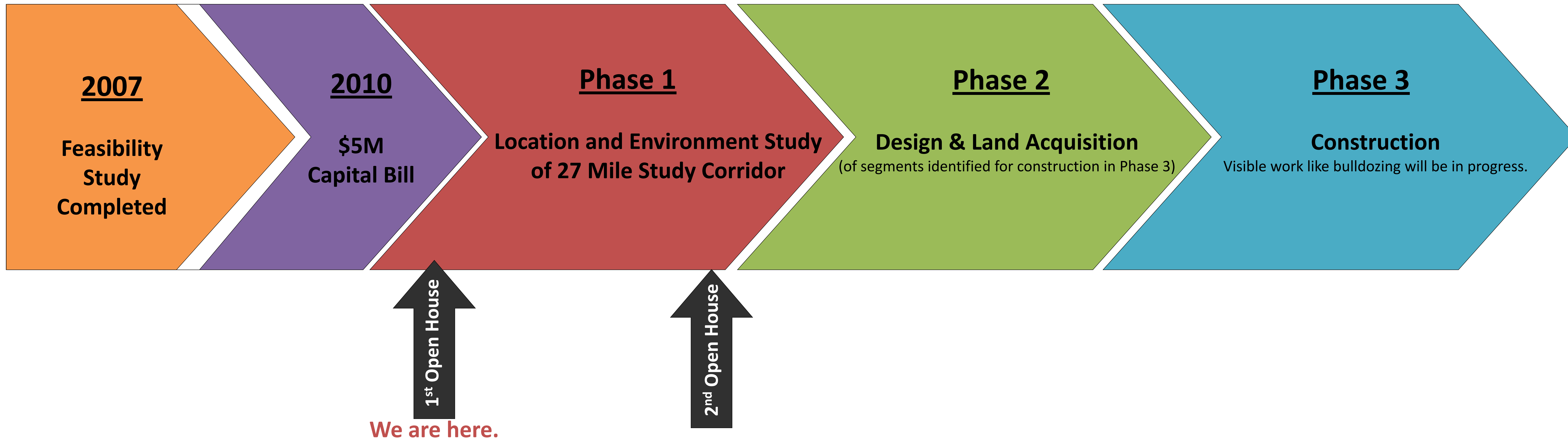


The Big Picture



2007 Feasibility Study

- **Broad-spectrum study covering a large area**
 - o Examined existing and future transportation demands, land use, and environmental issues along the US 50 corridor from west of I-57 near Salem to the US Route 50/County Road 21 interchange near Lawrenceville – a distance of approximately 75 miles.
 - o Identified the requirements and estimated the costs of upgrading the existing two-lane roadway to four-lane expressway standards.

2010 \$5M Capital Bill

- \$5 million identified for Phase 1 from Olney to Lawrenceville & for Phase 2 around Lawrenceville

2011-2013 Current Project Study

Phase 1

- **More refined study covering 27 mile study corridor**
 - o Further evaluates potential environmental impacts and displacements
 - o Conducts detailed traffic and land use studies
 - o Includes comprehensive public involvement and outreach
 - o Preliminary engineering ongoing

Phase 2

- **Detailed plan development for chosen construction segments and land acquisition of buildable piece (PARTIALLY FUNDED)**

Phase 3

- **Construction (NOT SCHEDULED OR FUNDED)**
